Goldendale School District 2019 Superintendent Selection Process

Parents, community members, students, and school employees are invited to be a part of the process that will help us select our next superintendent for the Goldendale School District.

Here are the steps that will be taking place as we select the next leader for our local schools:

- **Thursday, Jan. 17: Public focus group sessions** – Community members, school staff, and students are invited to participate in sharing their ideas and their input about the characteristics they are seeking for Goldendale Schools' next superintendent. These sessions at school locations will occur as follows:
 - ▶ 2:30 p.m. – High school students (at HS Library)
 - ▶ 2:30 p.m. – Middle school students (at MS Library)
 - ▶ 4:00 p.m. – School district administrators (at HS Library)
 - ▶ 4:00 p.m. – School district staff (at MS cafeteria)
 - ▶ 5:00 p.m. – School board (at District Office)
 - ▶ 6:30 p.m. – Community (at MS Cafeteria)
- **Monday, Feb. 4:** Goldendale School Board approval of superintendent vacancy announcement
- **Wednesday, Feb. 6:** Position advertised locally and on statewide resources
- **Wednesday, March 13:** Position closes
- **Wednesday, March 20, or Friday, March 22:** Superintendent candidates will be interviewed in Goldendale with opportunity for community participation (Location to be announced)
- **Monday, April 8:** Up to two finalists re-interviewed by Goldendale School Board (if necessary)
- **Optional April date to be determined:** Goldendale School Board members conduct site visits of finalists' schools (if needed)
- **Monday, April 15 (or earlier):** Goldendale School Board names new superintendent
- **Monday, July 1:** New superintendent begins position
